

Cuba Livestock Show Fair Book

2019

General Rules

1. The Cuba Livestock Show is open to any Fulton County 4-H or FFA dues paying member. There is no entry fee for this show.
2. Steers, commercial heifers, market lambs, gilts, and barrows will be weighed on the grounds before showing.
3. The decision of judges will be final.
4. All animals must be the property of the exhibitor from the beginning of the project year.
5. Sheep, Goats, and Swine must be in place by 7 a.m., Cattle and Horses by 9:00 a.m.
6. Heifers, sheep, swine, and goats must have a CVI(Certified Veterinary Inspection)
7. Sawdust will NOT be provided, bring your own.
8. All Steers and heifers must have been born after January 1st, 2018. All steers may be mouthed and those found with a set of permanent teeth will be disqualified.
9. No horned cattle.
10. All lambs/kids must be lambed/kidded after January 1st, 2019. All breeds show together. All market lambs must be slick shorn.
11. Swine must be farrowed after January 1st, 2019.
12. All animals must be stalled in the space provided. Keep animals in designated areas.
13. Bucket calf and little piggy shower class must show 2019 calf or pig, member must be younger than 8 before September 1. No placings will be awarded for this class. Entry form must be submitted for this class.
14. Superintendents will determine release times.
15. **Pens must be cleaned before animals are released.**
16. Showmanship classes will be for all species, Junior classes will be for those under 13, Senior classes for those 13 and over.

1. Exhibitors entering in walk/trot classes may not enter in riding classes which require a lope/canter. Walk/Trot exhibitors may enter in speed events but may not lope/canter.
2. Exhibitors are limited to one halter class per horse
3. Helmets required for all speed events.
4. Awards will be given for high point exhibitor in both Jr. & Sr. divisions.
5. Exhibitors in the Cuba Livestock Horse Show and the FFA Horse Show will compete together in the same classes, however please remember you need to enter into two classes in order to compete for both FFA and Cuba Livestock Show premiums. (e.g. If you would like to compete in FFA Horse Show and Cuba Livestock Show in the Western Halter Class you must enter in class H-2 and FFA-702.)
